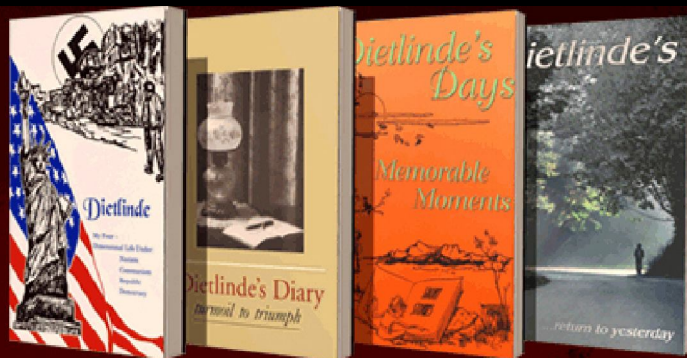
Dietlinde Spears
