From Baghdad to Nashville

Brentwood Hills Church of Christ-Nashville, TN September 9, 2017

Sunset International Bible Institute in Lubbock, TX is presenting a seminar on Islam on September 9 at the Brentwood Hills Church of Christ in Nashville. The seminar is designed to help Christians better understand Islam and to be equipped to better share the Good News of Jesus with Muslims. The speaker will be Wissam Al-Aethwai, who was raised in a Sunni Muslim family in Baghdad, Iraq. He rejected Islam and fell into atheism in the mid 1990's. He found a copy of the Bible in '97 and became a believer in '98. It took twelve years to find someone to baptize him in Iraq in May 2010. He is a graduate of Sunset International Bible Institute, is working to start an Arab-speaking congregation of the Lord's church in Dearborn, Michigan, and is an adjunct faculty member at Sunset working with congregations who want to better understand Islam and how they can reach Muslims. The seminar begins at 8:15 am, concludes at 12:30 pm, and is open to everyone. Brochures are available at the Information Booth.
